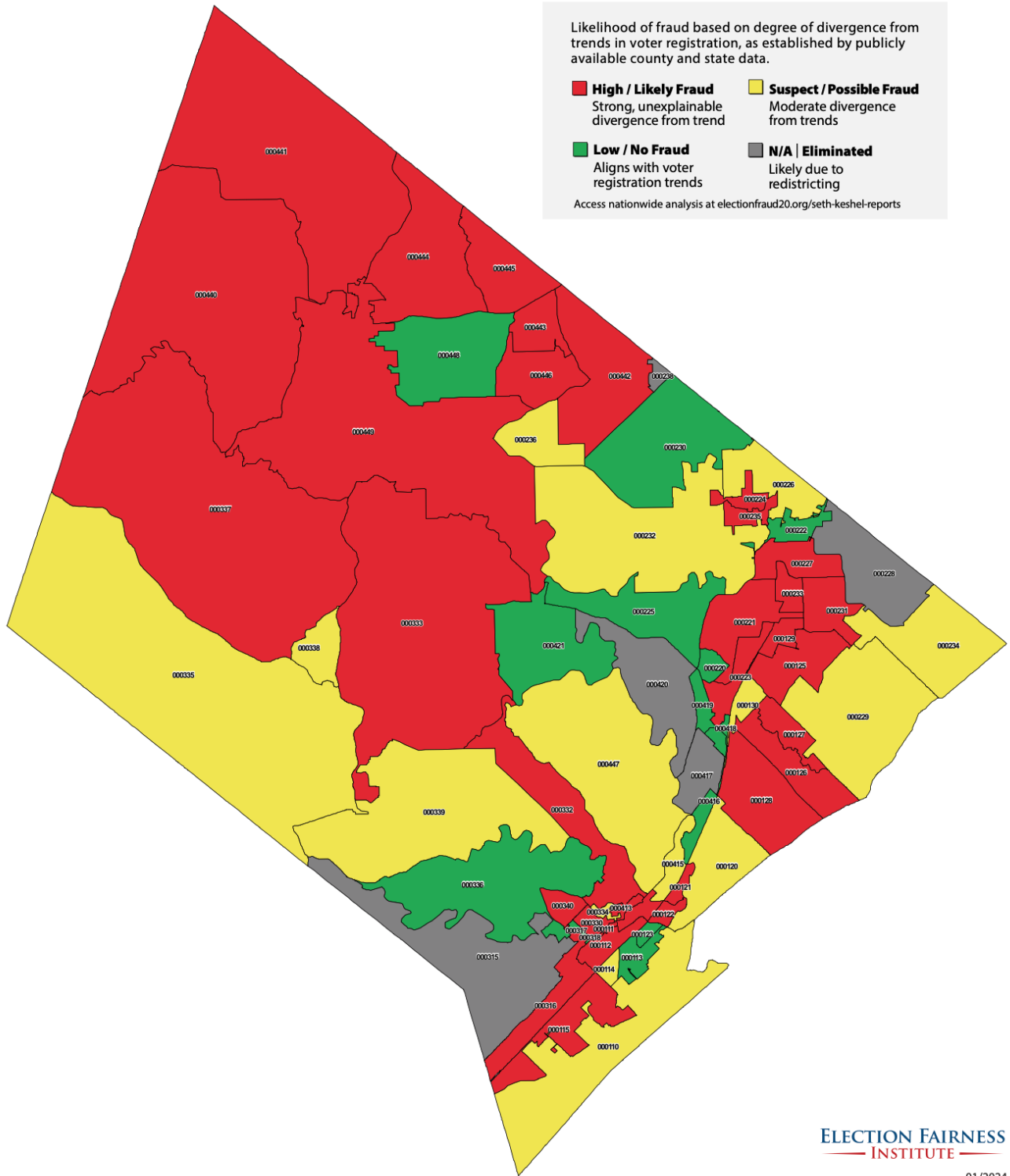

# Hays County, Texas

## Assessment

## Remarks

Hays County is a rapidly growing suburban county between San Antonio and Austin, the capital city of Texas. It has experienced substantial growth for decades thanks to out of state transplants and the expansion of the Austin metro, and in the 2010s, grew by the greatest number of net new residents in a single decade in county history. The county was once loyal to Democrat presidential nominees, but prior to the heavily manipulated 2020 election, had only backed one since 1980 (1992).

Some precinct equivalents in Hays County are expressed in groups of precincts as shown in this report. 20 precincts or precinct groupings (including 16 classified as *Republican* or *Competitive*) rank *high* for statistical indication of election manipulation, with each in that category containing at least 300 likely fraudulent ballots. The most highly disparate precincts are in the I-35 corridor in vicinity of growing communities such as Kyle and Buda in the northeast, and San Marcos in the southeast of the county. In the less developed areas of the county to the northwest, near Dripping Springs, substantial election manipulation also exists.

All precincts appearing in the *worst precincts* list should be prioritized for canvassing to identify voter registration illegalities and to investigate for ballot harvesting rings, which are known to exist in major Texas urban centers and are likely operating in nearby Austin. In addition to rapidly expanding housing developments, it is also likely that Texas State University near San Marcos is loaded with fraudulent transitory registrations that are common with counties known for large universities.
